Universal God One World Religion the Christian must return to biblical basics and biblical doctrines have always been important features of training the Saints to be strong and able to stand firm in God's cause. Jesus Christ, as presented by The Father and also Jesus' testimony is according to the Word, "And Jesus came and [...] ¹

When Jesus asked them about popular opinions of his identity, they recounted the rumors that he was John the

Baptist or one of the ancient prophets. Jesus then turned the focus on them: "But who do you say that I am?" Jesus insisted. When Peter spoke for them all and revealed that Jesus was the Messiah and "Son of the living God," Jesus blessed him for making that confession. "You are Peter {Petros}" Jesus said in a play on words, "and on this rock, {Petra} I will build my church," (Matt. 16:18).

The apostle Paul reports, that Jesus rescued us from the power of darkness and transferred us from the power of darkness and transferred us into the kingdom of his beloved Son. He writes in the beautiful poetic language of Jesus in (Col. 1:13), describing Christ's sovereignty. A passage celebrates Christ as creator and preserver of the universe, supreme over every creature. He is the head of his body, the church, and the first to conquer death. Although in Christ "all the fullness of God was pleased to dwell," Paul asserts, it was ultimately only through his human suffering ~ through "the blood of His cross," (Col. 1:19, 20), "That he was able to reconcile all things to God and make peace.²"

Satan's strategy in these last days is to get you to doubt the reality of Jesus and His power. However, for the most part, entire denominations today operate without the Holy Spirit. They are devoid of the presence of Jesus, bankrupt of all spiritual gifts. They practice a form of religion without any power, conviction or saving message. They have cultivated friendship with sin and ridiculing the supernatural by tossing aside all teachings about heaven, hell, repentance and God's judgment. They are spiritually weak, and cold. The world no longer fears them. They have no respect, and no influence and on society.³

Christian leaders' signs and wonders power consists of Kundalini demons flashing demonic powers. Now let's look at the following common manifestations of the risen Kundalini in occult practices as seen in the Third Wave. Spontaneous vocalizations (including laughing and weeping) — are as unintentional and uncontrollable as hiccoughs. Hearing an inner sound or sounds, classically described as a flute, drum, waterfall, birds singing, bees buzzing but which may also sound like roaring, whooshing, or thunderous noises or like ringing in the ears, Muscle twitches, cramps or spasms, Energy rushes or immense electricity circulating the body, Itching, vibrating, prickling, tingling, stinging or crawling sensations. Other sensations include: intense heat or cold, Involuntary bodily movements, jerking, tremors, shaking; feeling an inner force pushing one into postures or moving one's body in unusual ways, Emotional outbursts; rapid mood shifts; seemingly unprovoked or excessive episodes of grief, fear, rage, depression.

Flee from this spiritually sick, false prophets and return to Jesus.⁴

SPIRITUALIST AND THE RELIGIOUS WAR!

Theosophist, Alice Bailey, New Age prophetess, said in her New Age books that the next Great War would be in the field of world religions. She stated that the goals of the so-called new "Christ" included restructuring Christianity and abolishing Orthodox Judaism. 2 The precise nature of this planned conflict may be gleaned from Alice Bailey's writings: ⁵

"Years ago I said that the war which may follow this one would be waged in the field of the world religions." Bailey said, "This war would not be one of external carnage and blood but it would be fought largely with mental weapons and in the world of thought; it will involve also the emotional realm, according to idealistic fanaticism. This inherent fanaticism (found in every reactionary group) will fight against the appearance of the coming world religion and the spread of esotericism (occult). ⁶

For this struggle, certain of the well-organized churches through their conservative elements (their most powerful elements), are already girding themselves . . . Fanaticism,

entrenched theological positions, and materialistic selfishness will be found actively organized in the churches in all continents and of all denominations. They can be expected to fight for the established ecclesiastical order, their material profit and their temporal rule, and already are making the needed preparation."⁵

Bailey goes onto say, "The coming struggles will emerge within the churches themselves; it will also be precipitated by 1. The enlightened elements who exist in fair numbers already, 2. And are rapidly growing in strength through the impact of human necessity. The filth will spread to thinking men and women everywhere who in a protesting revolt have denied orthodox Christianity and theology. ⁶

Notice the battle plans. The field of battle is in the mental and emotional realm. In the same book, Alice Bailey states three planned activities of the "New Age Christ," one of which concludes: "The reorganization of the world religions if in any way possible so that their out-of-date theologies, their narrow-minded emphasis and the ridiculous belief that they know what is in the Mind of God may be offset in order that the churches may eventually be the recipients of spiritual inspiration."

She is talking about a total restructuring of the Christian faith by changing it from Godcentered too self-centered! Paul emphasizes this danger to the Church in his farewell talk to the elders of the Ephesians Church (Acts 20: 17-35). The Church today desperately needs to recognize this danger as the crisis we face.

"For I know this," Paul declares," that after my departing shall grievous wolves enter in among you not sparing the flock. Also, of your own selves shall men arise, speaking perverse things to draw away disciples after them" (vs. 29, 30). The Great deception will spring from the tares growing along a side the wheat in the Church. When wheat grows, the tares are indistinguishable until before the harvest. One has to be knowledgeable to discern the difference." The Holy Spirit will lead us into all truth if we are yielded to Him and His Word!

The devil can disguise himself as an angel of light. As Merrill F. Unger has put it, "With the crude savage Satan may best accomplish his purpose as a roaring lion but with the cultured and educated, he can work more effectively as an angel of light." Satan is a past master at being ingenious. His work can look very respectable on the surface. But behind the facade is immense power, vulnerable only to the authority of a Christian who believes in the power of the name of Jesus Christ. 8

Heresy is a serious thing, and nothing but a humble walk with God by His Word can keep us in His grace and in harmony with our brethren. ⁹ A new Wind and Fresh light from God's Holy Spirit is therefore an important necessity. This He gives us daily as new situations arise.

"The (**forces**) demons of the pit have gone forth to deceive the whole world (Revelation 12:12). The consequence is that great upheavals are happening in the political and religious world. ¹⁰ We must take account of these happenings, as they vitally affect the Church of Christ.

SEDUCING SPIRITS

It was the year 1981, when this author first heard of hypnosis openly trying to penetrate into the Body of Christ. I was attending a Christian writer's conference. The workshop teacher asked the question. "Have you ever given any thought to hypnosis as a God-given means of helping the Body of Christ?"

The question was shocking, having been delivered from the occult; I never dreamed hypnosis could be considered a tool for healing by a fellow Christian. Hypnosis, which was an anathema to anyone who professed Christianity in the West just a few years ago, is now a center-piece of **New Truth** in many ministries today.

The workshop speaker continued: "I challenge you to write materials with a fresh angle or new slant. We've heard the same old things. Last week, I helped write a brochure for a gentleman who has conferences on hypnotism. He is a psychologist. We wanted to show how there are certain capabilities in the human being that God put there. That hypnotism should not be something that is linked with Satan. We sent ads to several Christian magazines. They rejected them. We even emphasized the cross by capitalizing the "T" in the word "hypnotism." How can Christians justify entertaining these thoughts as being acceptable! God has demanded that the occult be outlawed.

The Bible says: "Regard not them that have familiar spirits, neither seek after wizards, to be defiled by them" (Leviticus 19:31). But, the fascination with wizardry repeatedly creeps back into popular favor. It needs to be denounced again and again by the faithful worshippers of the one God. How can we walk hand in hand with the spirit of darkness and expect to stand in the light of Christ?

WHAT IS SOUL FORCE?

Author, Jesse Penn-Lewis, tells of meeting a man in **North India** who had access to the highest circles of society in **Simla**, the summer seat of the **Government of India**. He told her of his connections with the **Mahatmas in India** and other countries of **Asia**. He said that he knew of great political events weeks and months before they came to pass. 'I do not depend for news on telegrams and newspapers. They only record past events, we know events before they happen," he said.¹¹

How can a man in **London** know the events happening in India, and vice versa? It was explained to Mrs. Penn-Lewis that it was a thing called '**soul force**'! "Soul force is being projected by men who know the secret of the Mahatmas. To the Believer, taught of the Spirit of God, in the light of the Word of God, it is the power of the pit projected upon the nation of the world to deceive them to cause catastrophic changes." ¹²

She says that "'soul-force' is a word whose charm and magic are only known in the East." It is the power exercised by holy men, known as Mahatmas. The Mahatmas were the

spiritual leaders in India in centuries gone by, and are credited with supernatural powers as much today as in ages past. Soul-force is said to have power, not only to energize, but also to control the will of another." ¹³

Penn-Lewis writes this 'soul-force' is believed to be cultivated by prayer, fasting, and religious meditation . . . Prayer is seen as an exercise of devotion uniting **Hinduism** and **Mohammedanism** in one common action, to generate 'soul-force' in order that it may be projected upon Western nations to undermine their power and prestige.¹¹ "It is the greatest revolt known in history! ..." ¹⁴

BEWITCHING SPIRITS

The Apostle Paul wrote with a grieved heart to the Galatians Church that he had lovingly labored with the Gospel of the Lord Jesus Christ. He wrote: "O foolish Galatians, who hath bewitched you, that ye should not obey the truth, before whose eyes Jesus Christ hath been 'evidently set forth, crucified among you," Galatians 3:1.

Paul inquired, "Who had bewitched the believers to draw them away from the truth." Effects upon them were not just the effects of wrong mental impressions conveyed by false teachers but were the effects of evils spirits imposing false doctrine through false teachers, (Galatians 3:1.) References do not suggest that believers enjoy an easy exemption from the activities of devils but are particularly targeted by them. In Timothy 4:1 and 2 - how wicked spirits attack the spiritual believer by deception beguile him away from the faith through the use of false prophets. "Now the Spirit speaks expressly, that in the latter times some shall depart from the faith, giving heed to seducing spirits, and doctrines of devils." Most believers have adopted the fallacious idea that if they ignore Satan, he will ignore them. Scripturally, such a position is indefensible," (I Peter 5:8, 9; James 4:7; II Corinthians 2:11).

OCCULT AVENUES OF INNER HEALING

C. H. Spurgeon, tells us: "The Church has never had worse enemies than false teachers; infidels and persecutors do but mild injury to her, but her heretical preachers have been as ravening wolves."

Christians have not escaped the deceptive influence of the **New Age Movement** . . . The recruiting of unsuspecting "**self-improvers**" continues. People who are encouraged to study one of the dozens of "psycho technologies" visualization, autosuggestion, hypnotherapy, guided imagery-techniques all almost guaranteed to bring one in contact with "spirit guides" or what Christians call demons." ¹⁵

"Silva Mind Control," "E S T," "A Course in Miracles," and several other mind "science" courses, are guaranteed to convert participants into **New Agers**. ¹⁶ Churches across the nation are into **The Holistic Movement**, Human Potential, meditation, trans personal psychology, biofeedback (which encourages use of Zen and meditation to maintain alpha waves)." These

psycho-technological-techniques are nearly guaranteed to either bring one under a state of possession or at least cause a loss of control through demon oppression and could even enhance the chance of becoming possessed." 17

Some researchers recognize that claims to a healing power from the unconscious, universal fields of energy, or a higher self, are really just the same spirit as healing. Parapsychologist and physician, Hans Naegeli-Osjord, states: "The healer attains the spiritual union, the "union mystical" (i.e., possession) with a spirit-protector, who is a saint of the church, or the creative cosmic field of force, the "higher self" of the Kahuna philosophy." ¹⁸

John Weldon and Zola Levitt in their expose' of an occult phenomenon, "Psychic Healing," John Weldon & Zola Levitt, authors go into detailed accounts of psychic healing, its occult roots, and why it is such a dangerous practice. More than just one of the strangest and most disturbing books you may ever read, this is a carefully researched, heavily documented expose of an alarming otherworld practice. They write: "Similarly, those who claim their healing power come from psychic abilities or some other source, sense the presence of spirit entities while healing." ¹⁹ Therefore, it is not coming from some latent power within a psychic's own abilities but from a spiritual source working through the individual. This power is then transferred to the subject who is seeking the healing. ⁷

If the Biblical view that man is not a supernatural being is correct, then all genuinely supernatural healing must come from one of two sources: God or Satan. What most people do not appreciate is that Satan rarely shows his true face, and he effectively operates under the guise of "true spirituality" (2 Corinthians 11:14). Hence the clear majority of occult healers claim their gift of "spiritual healing" comes from God." ²⁰

PSYCHIC INNER HEALING

Agnes Sanford's books and ministry have been hailed for decades throughout Christian circles . . . Although Sanford's writings are consistently occult in nature; she is the chief guru of the inner healers in the Christian Church. Rita Bennett, Author/Inner Healer, writes, "If you are dealing with a severely depressed person who is unable to cooperate with you or to visualize Jesus, you may need to use the "healing of memories" type of prayer. Agnes Sanford, that great lady who has helped so many understand healing," ²¹ both physical and psychological, originated this type of praying back in the 1950's. (Many leaders in the healing movement today owe their start to Agnes Sanford's inspiration and teaching.) In healing of memories, you do not ask the person to participate. You just ask Jesus to go back into the person's past memories and heal them, trusting God's gifts to guide in the prayer. It is usually helpful to lay your hands on the person's head while you do this. This way of praying can is very effective. If

Christians were to take **Christian Science** books and study them, then pattern their ministries based upon the information in those books, they would be practicing **Christian Science**. Christian ministries must be Bible based and God called.

We have already cited Sanford's Jungian psychological and metaphysical influences in her writings in at another place. We can also clearly see from her writings the influence of Eastern Religious influence. For instance: "Wise men of **India** for many centuries have trod the lofty peaks of spiritual power and given birth to their **oversouls**."²²

Webster's International Dictionary defines "**over soul**": "The absolute reality conceived as a spiritual being in which the ideal nature imperfectly manifested in human beings is perfectly realized and in which our finite and separate existences are grounded." ²³

America's occultist "Sleeping Prophet", Edgar Cayce, (who claimed to be a Christian,) for forty-three years, routinely entered self-induced trance states where he would clairvoyantly diagnose and recommend treatment for a wide range of ailments, sometimes thousands of miles removed from his patient. He could "see" (called remote viewing by occultist) the individual and would prescribe medicines and herbs to cure his illness. During his lifetime he produced over 14,000 "readings" as they were called. He said these over souls were: "bodies of the dead waiting to re-enter a body." ²⁴ Cayce was well aware of the fact that "spiritual beings" were assisting his ministry and even feared that some evil power might have been involved. ²⁵

Mrs. Sanford is not ignorant of the occult nature of what she has written about the terminology of "**over soul**" because she continues to explain: "Spirits of those (**dead**) for whom we have prayed on earth are working through us... (This is called spiritualism by occultist. It can also be called medium ship which is forbidden by the Word of God.)

One conveys that healing force, (Jesus is not a force) to the inner being (of the sick) through the law of suggestion... (Hypnosis). He (the person doing the healing) has made a thought-track (ESP) between his spirit, subconscious mind and body; and the body, the subconscious mind and the spirit of the patient... ²⁶

The Bible forbids "talking to the dead" (Deuteronomy18:18). The psychic-spiritist connection of Ms. Sanford's "newly devised technique" is really an arcane mystical formula in use since the beginning of pagan religions. Her beliefs are clearly those of a pantheist. Spirit-filled Christians believe the power of the Holy Spirit, the authority of the name of Jesus and His living Word is the only instruments of healing. The minister is only a vessel that God's power flows through to effect the healing. The question of "self" simply never enters into the picture of Christian Healing. It all depends upon Faith in God!

THE SOUL AND SPIRIT

Christians must now know for their own safety, the difference between 'soul and spirit." They must recognize the danger of ignorantly using "psycho-analysis" when dealing

with the personal problems of others. They should lead such souls to the Cross for deliverance, relying upon the **indwelling power of the Holy Spirit**. In "warfare" against the devil himself there can be an **actual development of Soul-force** unless there is a deep work of the Cross continually applied to the old Adam life. There must be a real life-union with the Risen Lord by the Holy Ghost. ²⁷

"Soul-force" versus "Spirit-force" is the battle ground today. The Body of Christ should be filled with the energy of the Holy Spirit always, advancing heavenward. The atmosphere of the world is thickening with psychic currents behind which are massed the aerial (spiritual) foes. The only safety for the child of God is in an experiential knowledge of life in union with Christ. We need to dwell with Christ in God, above the poisonous air where the Prince of the power of the air carries on his work. The blood of Christ cleanses us while the cross of Christ leads us to die to self. The Power of the Risen Lord, continually declared, laid hold of and wielded, will alone bring the members of the Body through in victory to join Him in the Heavenlies!

Jesus tells us: "Many will say to me in that day, Lord, Lord, have we not prophesied in thy name? And in thy name have cast out devils? And in thy name done many wonderful works? And then I profess unto them, I never knew you; depart from Me, ye workers of iniquity" (Matthew 7:22, 23).

John and Paula Sandford, (not related to Agnes) who are prominent in today's "inner healing" ministry have said of Mrs. Sanford that she was the forerunner in the field of inner healing by prayer, and she was also our own first mentor in the Lord, our friend and advisor . . . As a sound church woman, she . . . founded the **School of Pastoral Care** . . . " ²⁸ Many came to learn her "new gospel" of psycho techniques. Among them were Francis Macnutt, Barbara Shelemon, Tommy Tyson, Herman Riffel, Paula and John Sandford, and many others who have written or become noted about the healing of the "inner man". ²⁹

At the same when Agnes Sanford was exploring the potential of her healing prayer ministry, Glenn Clark's ministry of healing and writing was flourishing. Clark came from a devout Christian family and although he did not choose the formal ministry he was always active in the church. ³⁰ His writing, teaching, and healing career extended from the 1930's to the 50's. He published scores of books on prayer and spiritual life. In 1930, he established a Christian summer camp to train Christians to pray more effectively. He called this "Camps Farthest Out" (CFO) By the '40's, CFO'S were in every section of the country and several overseas. ³¹

In 1940, Mr. Clark published "**How to Find Health through Prayer**". A large section of this book is dedicated to the relationship between negative emotional states (**sin**) and illness. He writes: "If it is true that bad thoughts and bad emotions are reflected in bad health, and that hate thoughts become boomerangs upon those we love, then we surely have the Grace of God to thank for tempering justice with mercy. Most of us would have suffered far worse than we have, had the Lord exacted the full measure of Justice."³²

In this book Clark mentioned as one of the successful techniques of prayer the use of "positive visualization", that is, seeing the person healed in the mind's eye"; (as though the very fact of seeing one healed in one's mind would cause the healing. Healing does not come by imagination, but thru: (1) The Word of God, (2) Name of Jesus, (3) and faith.) ³³

Mr. Clark called a special meeting of Christian healers. Twenty-two came to exchange notes on healing prayer. Among those were Agnes Sanford, Roland and Marcia Brown and Genevieve Parkhurst. ³⁴ After this meeting, Mrs. Sanford became a major speaker at **CFO** camps on the topic of healing prayer, blending her shamanistic philosophy into her Biblical teachings. ³⁵

ENTRANCE OF REINCARNATION

The Bible tells us: "Let not many of you become teachers, my brethren, for you know that we who teach shall be judged with greater strictness" (James 3:1). The Apostle James illustrates the tremendous importance of teachers for the life of the Church and the need for those teachers to be faithful to their calling. Those who teach must find that responsibility rooted in Jesus Christ and His Word. We will "Grow in the grace and knowledge of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ" (2 Peter 3:18). This knowledge cannot be intermixed with man-made knowledge otherwise we will enter a "cult" or the occult. Apostasy from God is spiritual adultery. Strangers have devoured the strength of the Church in our day and have been weakened by evil associations.

"Visualization" and "Guided Imagery" have long been recognized by sorcerers of all kinds as the most powerful and effective method for contacting the spirit world to receive supernatural power, knowledge, and healing. Such methods are neither taught nor practiced in the bible as helps to faith or prayer. Those who try to do so are not following the leading of the holy spirit or the word of God, but are practicing an ancient occultic technique. ³⁶

Marcia Brown, occultist minister and writer, was also in attendance at Glenn Clark's first meeting at the Camps Farthest Out. Why would Mrs. Brown have been invited to a "Christian Leaders CFO Meeting"? Her beliefs and ministry were proved to be spiritualistic when she later wrote the book, "Hypersentience": Exploring Your Past Lifetime as a Guide to Your Character and Destiny." ³⁷ This book with its teaching of reincarnation is the most responsible for spreading the use of regression into past lives through hypnotism. It contains instructions for learning how to induce past lives in others and for guiding them through experience. Her seminars, and, the book "Hypersentience," were of importance to all sorts of metaphysical groups and even to professionals in the mental health fields.

Brown's first book on the theory of reincarnation came out in 1968.³⁸ The book emphasizes her beliefs in reincarnation and Eastern religion. She believed that **Karma** is the supreme law of the universe and that God is not even a shadowy figure in the background. She also believed there should be a radical separation between what she believed to be reincarnation and other religious doctrines.³⁹

Her procedures are simple: The "sensors," (participants) are briefed on the process of regression. After answering their questions the "entrancing process" is begun with a prayer-invocation. However, the prayer at the beginning of the relaxation procedures is not a prayer to God but a Gnostic hymn to "self" so that every person becomes aware of his or her own "true identity." ⁴⁰

"Imagination exercises" are used to help achieve a moderate to deep trance state. "The "sensor" is invited by the "facilitator" (the counselor) to visualize his personal guide (an invitation to spiritism) as his assistant in seeing past lives. Brown uses her own personal guides "spirits" (demons) to direct her in difficult regressions." ⁴¹

Mrs. Moore records one person's afterlife spent on a planet called "**Melina**." On this planet the girl is educated by her "**guides**"(**demons**). One of her guides is a spirit called Jesus who was supposedly "reincarnated on earth as Jesus". There is another guide on Melina called Pelu who is wiser and more loving than "Jesu". ⁴² She makes Jesus a second rate guide to another spirit who is found to be superior. She has no knowledge that we are blessed to have a Savior, Jesus Christ, Son of the Living God!

Mrs. Moore was later murdered and dismembered by the Satan-worshiping group she was researching. Only a piece of her skull was found. 43

Unfortunately, much of the inner healing ministry has taken a panthestic faith that has sidestepped Biblical Revelation and salvation.

EVOLUTION IN REGRESSION

Christians are in a battle, a struggle between the new faith in pseudo-science and faith in Christianity. Many consider the Bible to be mythical believing in Hegel's universal "mind-spirit"... that man's mind is directly linked to the great infinite mind and is a microcosm of it (universal consciousness). This faith in the god of science has driven intelligent man to supplant man's supremacy to that of animals. They believe in **Darwinism**, a notion that man, through a process of natural selection; have evolved to his present state from a common animal ancestry. Evolution has become a total break from the Biblical idea of God's creation.

Constance Cumbey writes that belief in evolution is a key component to the **New Age Movement**. "In fact, it is central to their theology. The Movement teaches that we have all evolved, but some of us have developed more highly than others just as some of us "**manifest our divinity**" more than others." ⁴⁴

Some psychiatrists are even "regressing" their patients into earlier forms of life in order to recall the deeper "memories" of their supposed experiences as apes, salamanders, or pollywogs. Jean Houston, who has PhD's in both religion and psychology, conducts workshops in which she leads participants to awaken these ancient "memories". The following excerpt from a reporter's account of one such session indicates the type of delusion that has become

commonplace among educated people who consider themselves too sophisticated to believe in God, sin, repentance and forgiveness through the sacrifice of a crucified and resurrected (not reincarnated) Jesus: 45

"Remember when you were fish," Dr. Houston suggested.

Nearly a thousand people...dropped to the floor and began moving their "fins" as if to propel themselves through water. "Notice your perceptions as you swim like a fish. How does your world look, feel, sound, smell, taste?" Then Houston suggested, "Allow yourself to fully remember being a reptile....Then some of you flew. Others climbed trees"...We became a zoo of sounds and movements made by early mammals, monkeys, and apes." ⁴⁶

The climax of the intense exercise that had already taken us more than an hour followed:

"Now I want you to extend yourselves even further into....the next stage of your own evolution." We became a room of leaping, joyous, sometimes alone, often together human beings who eventually joined hands and voices.

The impact was electric...

We had become a wriggling sea of bodies-nearly a thousand housewives, therapists, artists, social workers, clergy, educators, health professionals... (who) had crawled over and under each other, enjoying ourselves and re-learning what was deep within our memories." ⁴⁷

What an absolute web of deceit! How can supposedly intelligent-educated people believe such nonsense? The imagination is surely as evil as the Bible says and even more than we can ever imagine. Peter foretold the development of such heresies. "There were false prophets also among the people even as there shall be false teachers among you, who privily shall bring in damnable heresies, even denying the Lord that bought them, and bring upon themselves swift destruction. And many shall follow their pernicious ways; by reason of whom the way of truth shall be evil spoken of," (2 Pet. 2: 1, 2).

WHERE ARE WE GOING?

"Ye therefore, Beloved, seeing ye know these things before, beware lest ye also, being led away with the error of the wicked, fall from your steadfastness," (2 Pet. 3:17).

It is difficult to believe any Christian would be interested in hypnotizing or regressing another Believer into a so-called "past life experience". The Bible points out that we live once and then are judged (Hebrews 9:17:18). This leaves out the possibility of having another chance at life.

This writer has already pointed out that Christians are being regressed back to their mothers' wombs to "clean up illegitimate births or rejections at birth." Our born-again experiences are thought by these people as being "incomplete" or 'partial regeneration." After

womb regression, the next step is past lives deceptions. It is impossible to use avenues of the occult and then come up with Biblical conclusions. The Bible clearly tells us: "The Spirit speaketh expressly, that in the latter times some shall depart from the faith, giving heed to seducing spirits, and doctrines of devils..." (1 Tim. 4:1).

We are now into a second generation of inner healers. Many Biblically untrained, psychologically unskilled workers have come forth. They read a book and step into the experience. They have no idea that many of the techniques and words that they are using are, in fact, old time witchcraft. Because the words have power over their patrons and do cause psychological and sometimes emotional changes, they actually believe this to be from God. They play the role of mediums. However, it is clearly the preaching or teaching of "another Jesus" as warned against in the Scriptures which state:

"But I fear, lest by any means, as the serpent beguiled Eve through his subtlety, so your minds should be corrupted from the simplicity that is in Christ. For if he that cometh preacheth another Jesus, whom we have not preached, or if ye receive another spirit which ye have not received, or another gospel, which ye have not accepted ... " (1 Cor. 11: 2-4).

Occult mediumship is sorcery. All occultism is forbidden in both the Old and New Testaments. Satan's tools are always deceptive and destructive. There haves always been true and false prophets living side-by-side in the Bible. That's why Paul told us to be "discerning Christians" in (1 Cor. 2:15), "He that is spiritual (pneumatikos) judgeth all things." Also, Jeremiah warns us in the Old Testament to beware of false prophets. "And the Lord said to me, the prophets are prophesying lies in my name; I did not send them, nor did I command them or speak to them. They are prophesying to you a lying vision, worthless divination, and the deceit of their own minds." (Jer. 14:14.)

The Churches' spiritual advance is being tested as never before and she sometimes seems inadequate to meet the need. A fresh light from God is therefore an imperative necessity, as new situations arise. 48

Satan is attacking the Church by sending deceivers into our midst. Every Christian heart desires unity. Unity, Unity, is upon every Christian's lips. Nevertheless, unity depends upon obedience to God's Word while humbly following his Son Jesus Christ. Everyone who says "Lord, Lord", shall not enter the Kingdom of God; only the ones who do the will of God.

"Now the Spirit speaketh expressly that in the latter times some shall depart from the faith, giving heed to seducing spirits, and doctrines of devils; Speaking lies in hypocrisy; having their conscience seared with a hot iron," I Tim. 4:1. "The successful infiltration and acceptance of New Age doctrines through "big names and big ministries" reminds one of the Scripture found in Galations 3:1: "O Foolish Galatians, who hath bewitched you, that ye should not obey the truth, before whose eyes Jesus Christ hath been evidently set forth, crucified among you?" We must pray for the Church of Jesus!


